**Footnotes**

STOP THE RACE vied for the lead two wide into the turn, repelled challenger in mid-turn then drew away through the lane. LINE EURO chased the pace from off the inside, moved closest to the winner in the lane and could only finish second best. DANCE MAN was off the rail through the turn, moved closer to the inside for the drive and moved up for the minor share. ASK SIDNEY chased the pace from the three path into the lane then lacked a response. KARENSLITTLEBUDDY vied with the winner along the inside into the turn then faded after mid-turn. TAILOR'S CUT was steadied entering the turn when put in tight then was never a serious factor. MAJOR ALLIANCE was never a threat while in the four path through the turn. QUICK AMERICAN was never a factor while in the three or four path. SAVIANO showed brief speed entering the turn then retreated. FLY ME NOW was in the six to seven path throughout. OUR CAT raced well out from the inside and in the seven path into the lane. STORM PASSER BYE bid through the turn from the inside then was being eased to the wire in distress.
