JEFF THE CLOCKER was unhurried early while on the inside into the turn then rallied in the stretch and edged clear late under a steady drive. LEON NOACK chased the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn then led in the stretch but faltered late in the stretch. GOVERNOR GENERAL was well placed early, angled into the five path in the turn and weakened late. TIME BOMB stalked the dueling leaders early, angled into the four path in the turn with no late bid in the stretch run. HARD ROCK MAN broke out at the start, angled into the five path in the turn and faded late in the stretch. MAGIC DE NASKRA dueled early, angled off the rail into the turn and gave way in the stretch drive. SILVER CADILLAC was through after a half. RONNIE CLADY was bumped at the start while no factor. SLEW CITY SLIM was never involved. MICHAELS REVENGE showed little. MILITARY MIND was done early. SPACE DELIVERY had brief speed then retreated.
