**Footnotes**

WINKATDAWAT dueled for the lead two wide the entire trip, remained on near equal terms inside the eighth pole then inched to the front late. BILLIONS BOY dueled for the lead along the inside into the lane then could not match strides with the winner late in a game effort. MAJOR ADVANTAGE was off the rail through the turn, moved three wide into the lane and moved up for the minor share while not a threat to the the top two. ROMAN DICTATOR chased the pace from the two path into the lane then lacked a closing response. KEENUS FROM LOUISA raced along the inside into the lane then passed tired ones while saving ground throughout. CARL'S C NOTE was never a factor from the three or four path. SNOW JADE chased the pace along the inside for half then tired. COSMIC TRANSIT chased the two horse duel through the turn then faded. RYANS JOY was close early from off the inside, moved five wide into the lane then retreated.
