PAIGE MORO hustled up outside staying with the pace, was in the seven path on the turn, dueled gamely when straightened away, edged briefly clear then just lasted. INDY FIRE rated off the pace, bid in the five path on the turn, eased out into the stretch, gathered momentum from midstretch and just missed. ALLIE'S HOPE rated with the pace, contested the turn from the three path and between horses, continued on to the sixteenth pole and yielded late. APRICE chased the pace inside, bid in the four path on the turn and finished well toward the outside. CONNIES TRAVELS, off the pace inside, bid on the rail from the top of the stretch and finished well. FRAN'S GLORY pressured the pace from the inside, contested the turn saving ground then weakened the final sixteenth. MADAME EXPRESS ran off the rail through the turn and was empty in the stretch. KITTI GLITTER stayed with the pace, dueled between horses in the five path on the turn then weakened in the drive. GRANNY'S HOPE never factored. ENDEAVOR SKY never factored. MS IDA DEALER was no factor. SEE YOU IN AMERICA became unsettled at the start, made a mild bid in the seven path on the turn then tired.
