LIONS N LEGS chased the three horse duel through the turn while in the four path, moved five wide into the lane then gained momentum inside the eighth pole and finished with good energy to be up in time. PROUD AND FAST was never far back while saving ground, moved up late in the turn and was blocked near the quarter pole, taken up and waited for room, got through near the three-sixteenths pole, gained the lead near the sixteenth pole then could not hold off the winner. CALERA APPEAL was unhurried early while off the inside, bid from the five path into the lane and finished with good energy. PRETTY GAL TOO vied for the lead along the inside with two others, repelled those entering the lane then yielded to the others. HANOVER ROAD vied for the lead three wide into the lane and weakened. QUEEN'S DYNASTY vied for the lead from between rivals into the lane then tired. KEITH'S KITTEN was through after half from off the inside.
