MAN FROM MARS set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then drew clear late in the stretch under a steady drive. OUR DEVIL'S HALO stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late in the drive. GARCON tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch. THANKS BE TO GOD was well placed early, angled into the five path in the turn with some late gain. HALFMINEHALFYOURS broke in and bumped rival at the start then chased the pace early, while on the inside into the turn with no late gain in the stretch. BELLA'S FELLA broke awkwardly at the start, fanned into the seven path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch. ROOF TINNER angled into the three path in the turn and faded late. BURNING SWORD was bumped at the start while no threat. DAMION E. T. was never a factor. JUSTATHOUGHT was done early. MUTAKDDIM'S CROWN showed little.
