PURPLE JEAN set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then remained clear in the stretch and held sway late. PLATINUM BLUE stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late and was second best. ARROGANTLY SHABBY was well placed early, angled into the four path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. DISGRACE chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and was empty in the stretch drive. MY FOREST improved position. IMPERIAL FAX was never a factor. CARISSA K showed little. FROSTING was done early. NORA ROSE was through after a half. DOLLYS SONG was never involved. A P PASSION was always outrun.
