SMARTEST SECRETARY was well placed early, angled into the five path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch and drove past the leader in the final stages. SPOOF stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn then led in the stretch but yielded late in the drive. KRISTA chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch run. CLEAR THE CLOVER trailed the field early, fanned into the seven path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late. QUIET POLA set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and gave way in the stretch drive. SPEEDY WAR tracked the pace early, swung into the six path in the far turn and was empty in the stretch.
