Footnotes

TRUE STARLET settled off the early pace while in the two or three path, bid four wide near the quarter pole, moved to near even terms with the leaders straightening in the lane then edged to the front after an extended drive. CONGAREESBUTTERCUP pressed the pace three wide through the turn, moved to duel three wide in late turn, repelled dueling challengers into the lane then could not stay with the winner while finishing second best. CHECKITOFF vied for the lead from between rivals through the turn and into the lane then weakened inside the eighth pole. SHARI BOMB was never a serious threat while in the two or three path throughout. BUZZ MY BELL was never a factor while in the three path. BRACKETOLOGY was outrun while near the inside. BANNER YEAR vied for the lead with two others into the lane then faded. MARIGO tracked the early duel while along the inside then retreated approaching the quarter pole.
