T. L. SENSATION stalked the pace early then steadied along the backstretch, angled into the three path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch and drove past the leader in the final stages. RAPID WARRIOR came in early in the backstretch and set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn, remained clear in the stretch but yielded in the late stages. DAMION E. T. was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the turn with a late gain in the stretch run. NORTHERN REVEAL was well placed early, angled into the four path in the turn and flattened out late in the stretch drive. MARDI GRAS PARTY angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. SHORT SALE angled into the three path in the turn and improved position. STORMIN' BUFFALO was never a threat. FLYLIKABIRD steadied hard along the backstretch. COMING ON had brief speed then folded up. DRAKE'S DANCER hopped at the start then was forced in along the backstretch and steadied. THERE WAS NO CHANGE AFTER A STEWARDS INQUIRY AFTER THE RACE.
