WHAT ABOUT RUBY pressed the pace early then took over command, angled off the rail into the turn then drew off in the stretch under a brisk drive. DELROSE chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn while no match for the winner in the stretch but was second best. VICTORIA BLU was well placed early, angled into the four path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. JACKIE'S LADY LUCK stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and was empty in the stretch drive. VISUAL ARREST bobbled at the start, angled into the five path in the turn and improved position. BATESBURG angled into the five path in the turn while no threat. DOWN ON COPPERLINE was through after a half. KELA'S AMY was bumped at the start then was rushed up and eventually spent. SAINT D'AROAK was never involved. OFFICIALLY had early speed then retreated. LILLEANDRA was done early. MARQUED FOR GLORY was outrun.
