OLD SMOOTHIE was under pressure throughout while along the inside, maintained a narrow advantage with an eighth to go then inched up to be clear late. SEATTLE BY THE SEA pressed the winner two wide from the outset then lacked the needed response late. STREAK O GREY stalked the pacesetters from the three path through the turn, was gaining momentum in the lane when dropping in toward the inside near the sixteenth pole then could not gain thereafter. STORMIN' BUFFALO chased the pace along the inside into the lane, got an open lane late and finished with good energy. CLIFF'S BEST BET chased the pace from the two or three path, was looking to split rivals near the sixteenth pole when shut off and lost all chance. POPS IS TOPS bid four wide into the lane, was in good position with and eighth to go then flattened late. ROYAL CROWN COSMO bid three wide into the lane then weakened in the drive. SHORT SALE was never a factor while widest through the lane. AFTER AN OBJECTION #8 STREAK O GREY WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED FIFTH FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH.
