Footnotes

HAARMAN settled off the pace from the two path through the turn, bid leaving the turn, found best stride just inside the eighth pole and was full of run at the end to just get up in time. STORMIN' BUFFALO chased the pacesetter from the three path through the turn, bid inside the eighth pole, steadily gained on the top spot inside the sixteenth pole then was outfinished from along the rail by the winner. TURNTHCRANK sprinted clear soon after the start, remained clear into the lane then gave ground grudgingly the last seventy yards. GARTH MAN raced four wide into the lane while appearing to gain momentum then finished evenly the last eighth. IRON HOOF was unhurried early from off the rail, fanned widest into the lane then passed a few tired ones. FINSBURY saved ground into the lane then weakened in the drive. MORO PROSPECTOR raced in mid-pack from the three path then lacked a rally. FLASHY PROSPECTOR was three wide through the turn then lacked a rally. ANTICIPATEDARRIVAL chased the pace along the inside into the lane then tired. TAKING LOUIE was outrun while in the three or four path through the turn. THE KING STINGER was outrun from the three path.
