LIL DOTTIE set the pace throughout, repelled one challenger entering the far turn, was joined by another soon after, maintained a short advantage into the lane then slowly inched away. RARE ACTION chased the pace from the three path into the turn, bid three wide into the lane, loomed a serious threat then could not get past the winner while far clear for the place spot. CARLEY TOWN was along the inside through the turn and could only manage to hold the show spot. SUPRISE SWITCH was in the two or three path into the far turn while in contention then lacked a response. KEYBOARD COWGIRL stalked the pace two wide into the turn then faded. SCHMOOZING was never a serious threat while trailing throughout.
