Footnotes

BOUNTY HUNTER set the pace early from the inside, angled off the rail into the turn, cleared the field late in the stretch under a steady drive. STEEL RED chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. CRAFTY SCOUT tracked the pace early while four wide, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch. SLIVER was back early, swung into the six path in the turn with a late gain in the stretch drive. R. P. INDY was well placed early, swung into the six path in the turn while no threat late. RAHY NIJMIS pressed the pace early from between horses, while on the inside into the turn and faded late. EZEL was never a factor. MUCH TO DO showed little. INTRUDER was done early.
