MOTOWN BOY set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn, drew off in the stretch while being ridden out to the wire. SIR JIM tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn while no match for the winner in the stretch run. BRENT THE BANKER chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late. SIAGON TRAFFIC COP stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn while making a bid but faded late in the stretch run. TOUGH LITTLE NUT angled into the three path in the turn while no threat. SEEYOUINAHUMMER was done early. GOLDEN LAUCHER flipped pre-load. CLIFF'S LONGSHOT showed little.
