TRULY A MYTH settled off the early pace while near the inside, bid two wide through the turn when challenging for the lead, gained the advantage into the lane then drew off and was ridden out. TRULY ELECTRIC was bumped at the start, moved up four wide through the turn t get nearest the winner then could not keep up with that one while second best. MISS NOON BY DOON broke in and bothered several rivals, raced on the lead into the latter part of the turn then gave way to the top two. CANADIAN VICTORY was in the three path through the turn and moved up while never a threat. SMART REASON tracked the pace along the inside into the lane then lacked a response. GLOWING PROSPECT was never a factor while near the inside. MAGGIE'S PLEASURE was bumped soundly from both sides at the start, raced along the inside into the lane and never factored. AUNT MARCIE was shut off and checked at the start losing all chance. GOT THE CALL was through after going a half from the three path. TRIPLE RICH was slow to gather and never in it. AFRICA QUEEN early speed from the four path then steadily faded. AFTER A STEWARDS INQUIRY #11 MISS NOON BY DOON WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SEVENTH FOR INTERFERENCE AT THE START.
