WILD SIP was bumped early then chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then took over command in the stretch and was driven clear late under a steady drive. ROYAL GENT vied for the lead early while three wide then took over the lead in the turn, angled into the three path inside the quarter pole while still with a bid in the stretch, yielded late in the drive. FAITH DELIVERED stalked the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch run. TOP JOHNNY pressed the pace early from between horses, angled off the rail into the turn and faded late. SEARCH THE LOU was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the turn and improved position. O WHAT A DREAM was through after a half. FORTYFOUR HUNTER was done early. MY SON DARREN was never a factor. KEELBACK was bumped early and outrun. THREE CARAT CAT had brief speed then folded up.
