BOY'S BROTHER BOB chased the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn then took over command in the stretch and drew clear in the final stages. BELLAMY JONES pressed the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. T. L. SENSATION was well placed early, angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. ALKE POKER set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and faltered late in the stretch. NICKERS FOR CANDY swung into the six path in the turn while no threat. RAILROAD ROY was never involved. MISTER MOORELAND stumbled at the start. HIGH SKY showed little.
