MO FASTER tracked the leader from the outside then took over the lead, angled four wide into the turn then drew clear late under a brisk drive. LAZ HAS RISEN led briefly then saved ground into the turn but was no match for the winner late while second best. PL'SHARD KNOT was well placed early, angled four wide into the turn then flattened out in the drive. ANOTHER FINE ONE raced up close early, angled four wide into the turn while no threat. MAJESTIC JACK pressed the pace early, angled three wide into the turn then faded. EGGEMOGGIN REACH angled off the rail into the turn while no factor. HOOSIER REDNECK angled six wide into the turn and never menaced. BOLD ANNOUNCEMENT swung widest into the lane and outrun. JORDON'S CRISIS trailed throughout.
