Footnotes

HIGH SKY set the pace on a clear lead into the lane then was kept to the task to maintain a diminishing advantage. WAKI TRICK chased the pace from the three path into the lane then steadily gained to the end. LEATHERNECK chased the pace from the three path into the lane, was well placed into the lane then lacked a bid. STREAK O GREY raced along the inside into the lane then moved up. FERDIE'S GUY raced in the four or five path into the lane then moved up. EL GRAN DAN was never a factor from the four to six path. CHURCH GROOM hopped at the start, raced near the inside into the lane then lost ground through the lane. STEPPIN AHEAD was never a factor from the three path. CROWN VADER tracked the pace from the inside into the lane then faded. IDAMANN was outrun near the rail. COMPLETELY WAKI was through after traveling a half from the two or three path.
