MOONSHINE STILL vied for the lead along the inside throughout and edged up inside the sixteenth pole. DOCALOT vied for the lead two wide through the turn and into the lane and finally yielded to the winner late. FATHER ART settled to the inside through the turn, remained close to the rail for the stretch run and slowly gained on tiring rivals. BEG MEL was in the three path through the turn, fanned into the four path for the drive and was finishing with good energy too late. RYAN'S THUNDER chased the pace from the three path into the lane and lacked a rally. MAGIC ROCK was never a factor while near the inside. OUR LUCKY SOX was through after half while along the inside. BROTHER JAMIE was off to an awkward start, hit the gate and was steadied and lost all chance. VERY CLEAR chased the early pace from the three path and retreated.
