EUROSTEEL stalked the pace early, took over command, angled off the rail into the far turn, drew off in the stretch under a steady drive. NAVAJO PARK broke awkward from the gate, angled into the four path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch. FIFTY GOLD was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the far turn and improved position. LEGIONARY was well placed early, angled into the three path in the far turn and weakened late. BRYNNIE'S MR. SMEE raced up close early, while on the inside into the far turn and was empty in the stretch run. PLEASANTLY WILD was factious in the gate, tracked the pace early from the inside, angled off the rail into the far turn and faded late. RUBADAR was through after a half.
