Footnotes

RONALDO was bumped at the start moved to track the pacesetters through the turn while along the inside, got through entering the lane when leader vacated the rail, gained a lead inside the eighth pole then was kept to the task to last. CASE CLOCKER vied for the lead two wide through the turn, repelled the dueling challenger near the eighth pole then was outfinished by the winner from along the inside. CAVANAUGH vied for the lead along the inside into the lane, remained in contention with an eight to go then gave way. PUBLISH settled off the pace while in the three path, came into the lane from mid-track and passed a couple of tired rivals while not a threat. WIN TUCKER stalked the two horse duel into the turn, moved up to near even terms in late turn then tired through the drive. SWEETEST RHYTHM was in the three path through the turn when never far back, was roused in mid-turn then tired.
