Footnotes

SODA JERK settled off the early pace while in the two or three path, moved quickly in late turn and four wide to close in on the leaders, moved closest to the leader after straightening in the lane then drove past that one near the sixteenth pole. ARABIAN CHEETAH vied for the lead along the rail, shook off the challenger entering the turn to gain a clear lead then could not go with the winner while clearly second best. LIGHTNING ROAD was unhurried early while off the inside, bid five wide into the lane then moved up from mid-track but was not a serious threat. QUEBEC CITY was challenging for the early lead while near the inside, pulled off the duel to chase the pacesetters through the turn then was empty in the lane. JINETE was along the inside into the lane and lacked a bid. ORIENTATION HALL was in the three path into the lane, moved to mid-track for the drive and was never a menace. TREASURE HUNTER vied for the lead two wide through the turn then faded.
