DAKOTA DIM stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn, took over command in the stretch, drew clear and held sway in the final stages. DUE FOR A CHANGE chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but hung late. BE BACK DUST set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and faltered late in the stretch drive. A ROSE FOR LISA was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. UNAPOLEGTIC raced up close early, angled into the four path in the turn and weakened late. NEWFOUND STAR tracked the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and faded late. JOURNEY TO THE TOP was through after a half. O'LEECOWBATMAN was done early.
