DISTORTED PROMISE was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the far turn, angled out in the stretch and won going away. QUIET HOME stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn while no match for the winner in the final stages. LEINSTER LADY set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn and faltered late in the stretch run. MY DELLA was well placed early, angled into the four path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch. DIVA MOON angled into the four path in the far turn while no threat. NATIVE KITTEN broke awkward from the gate, while on the inside into the far turn and faded late. ENGLISH TEACHER was never involved. EXCITEMENT (IRE) pressed the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and retreated in the stretch.
