Footnotes

SMOKEY THE BANDIT chased the pace from the three path through the turn, bid into the lane, moved to near even terms with the pacesetter outside the eighth pole then suddenly drew away approaching the sixteenth pole. SULTRY DEMEANOR set the pace into the lane while in the two path, was challenged near the eighth pole, was still a challenger outside the sixteenth pole but gave way. OUTLAW ZEN chased the pace from the four path into the lane and was all out to gain the show spot. JACK IN THE PULPIT was along the inside into the lane, was clear in the drive and hung inside the eighth pole. KOKA KOLA OCEAN was in the three or four path through the turn and never factored through the lane. SEA OF ENQUIRY was never a serious menace while saving ground. MARATHON MOON chased the pace from the three path into the lane and was empty for the drive, was vanned off to the barns. ROYAL PRIDE was outrun from the four path. ENORMOUS STORM was in mid-pack from the two or three path through the turn then was finished entering the lane.
