**Footnotes**

WILD ORATION vied for the lead from between rivals through the turn and in the two path, continued on near even terms with the others into the lane, dispatched of two challengers then was all out to hold sway. GOLFSHOT was along the inside through the turn, angled to the five path for the drive and finished with good energy. LADY LANNIS tracked the pace along the inside into the lane, bid inside the eighth pole, looked a serious contender with a sixteenth to go then could not sustain the effort. CORNER GIRL maneuvered off the inside approaching the far turn when behind a wall of rivals, continued in the four path into the lane, was fanned into the six path for the drive and offered a mild gain. FAITH'S FORTUNE vied for the lead along the inside into the lane then gave way. ZONE was never a factor while in the three or four path through the turn. STORM N ROSIE LACE never threatened while moving into the lane from close to the inside. THEMOONANDTHESTARS vied three wide through the turn when battling for the lead then tired. THERES ALWAYS HOPE hopped at the start, was hustled to be close while in the three path into the lane then faded. REMEMBER THE NIGHT was through early while in the four path.
