Footnotes

OLD SCUDDER was reserved early, swung six wide into the far turn then rallied in the stretch and drew clear in the late stretch while confidently ridden. DUBLINER (BRZ) chased the pace, angled three wide into the far turn but was no match for the winner late. CHASING THE GHOSTS hopped at the start then quickly recovered to track the early pace, angled three wide into the far turn and led late in the stretch but faltered in the drive. ROMEO'S BEQUEST was back early, fanned five wide into the far turn with a mild rally in the stretch. GALLOPING GOURMET was well placed early, angled four wide into the far turn with no late gain. FAMOUS FROLIC stalked the pace from between horses, angled off the rail into the far turn and weakened late in the stretch run. HUM THAT TUNE angled three wide into the far turn while no threat. FOUL TROUBLE raced up close early then checked in the backstretch and faded. AWKWARD MOMENT set the pace early while on the inside into the far turn and gave way in the stretch from the inside. LEMON DROP HIGH was always outrun.
