SKY AND ELI stalked the pace three wide through the turn, bid entering the lane then prevailed after a long drive. BIG REECE set the pace from the two path into the lane, was caught by the winner inside the eighth pole and slowly gave ground. SIR DAKOTA settled off the pace while in the three path through the turn, bid from the four path into the lane then was gaining at the end. DR. BLUE GROOM raced in the two or three path into the lane then offered a mild bid. POPS IS TOPS chased the pace from the two path into the lane then lacked a bid. LIFT HIGH THE FLAG was unhurried while saving ground through the turn then offered a belated gain. ITSA HOLIDAY tracked the pace along the inside into the lane then faded. GOLD RAKER was through early from along the inside. EL BARTO trailed throughout while near the rail.
