BETROTHAL vied for the led along the inside into the turn, repelled challenger late in turn then drew off and was kept to the task to the end. ORBISTON PARVA was unhurried early while in the three path, bid into the lane, came in near the three-sixteenths pole then could only mildly gain on the winner. SPLASHDOWN was near the rail through the turn, was gaining momentum into the lane when brushed by rival then could not launched the needed response. FRANCES GARDNER was void of speed, fanned into the six path into the lane and finished with good energy while belatedly. ARCHLY was steadied soon after start, raced along the inside into the lane and moved up while never a threat. KAZOOM was never a factor while in the three or four path into the lane. GATITO'S ALEGRIA chased the pace three wide into the turn then faded. GRACE OF GOLD pressed the pace into late in the turn then retreated through the lane. REBA'S VALUES was through after going a half while three wide. CIAO BELLINO was forced wide into the first and never menaced.
