Footnotes

LA ESCONDIDA stalked the dueling pacesetters while in the two or three path, bid near the quarter pole, gained a lead outside the eighth pole then drove clear. SIX CARAT pressed the pace along the inside, got past the dueling challenger leaving the turn but was no match for the winner while just lasting for the place spot. ALL AFLAME was unhurried through the turn while in the three path, came four wide into the lane and was slowly gaining to the end and just missed the place spot. PIG TAILS FLYIN was unhurried early while off the rail, traveled through the four path through the turn, fanned five wide into the lane and was never a serious threat. LITTLE WAKI tracked the pace along the inside then lacked a serious bid through the lane. MOROS FANTASTIC was in tight early, steadied out of the position and lost momentum, raced well off the rail into the lane and lacked a response. TRAILINTHETWOODS moved three wide through the turn when close up then tired in the lane. HERS FUNNY set the pace while in the two path through the turn then gave way after straightening in the lane.
