AZICHARMYOU dueled early, angled into the four path in the far turn then shook clear in the stretch while drifting in and out and lasted late at the wire. PATCHEN PRINCE was well placed early, angled into the four path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch but did not have enough late. CUB'S POWER was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the far turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. WAIT ON TATE dueled early, angled into the five path in the far turn and weakened late. DUTY ROSTER was never far back early, angled off the rail into the far turn with no late bid. WATCHINGIRLSGOBY tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and faded late. SIRIUS BLACK angled into the five path in the far turn with no rally in the stretch. HORSE DOCTOR had early speed then retreated.
