FOREVER SURE settled off the pace from the three path, waited near the quarter pole to get clear, remained behind a wall into the lane, shifted to mid-track then drove past and cleared late. WHAT A LOOSECANNON was unhurried while in the three or four path into the turn, moved five wide when gaining momentum, continued on with good foot into the lane, gained the lead inside the sixteenth pole then was outfinished. LAZ HAS RISEN chased the pace from the three path into the lane then lacked a closing response. MY BOY JO bid through the turn along the inside, was in good position into the lane and hung late. SIR WALTER'S ORO chased the pace along the inside into the lane then weakened. BELLAMY JONES set the pace into the lane then gave way. BULLNOSE BRICK was in the three or four path through the turn and never factored. GAME DRIVE was in mid-pack through the turn while in the three path and tired entering the lane. TIGERDUDE was never a factor while saving ground. DOIN BIG BIDNESS was outrun from off the inside.
