Footnotes

EMMA'S WISH raced through the four path while unhurried into the turn, bid leaving the turn while three wide then edged to the front and was under pressure to hold. FLUSH DRAW raced in the five path through the turn while gaining, fanned five wide near the quarter pole then was slowly gaining on the winner late. RED FOX FIRE raced in the three path through the turn, fanned four wide into the lane then hung late when in good position. LIGHT ON HER TOES raced off the rail into the lane, was gaining momentum when blocked in the lane, waited, cleared then finished evenly late. PISTOL'S BABY DOLL bid through the turn from just off the rail then flattened out in the lane. A FEW Z'S dueled from the outside then gave way in the lane. GANSTA AFFAIR raced in good position into the turn then tired. FEVER N CHILLS dueled from the inside then tired. SUPREME BIDNESS raced close up early from the inside then quit.
