LAWYER DAGGETT set the pace into the turn, widened the advantage into the lane then was all out to hold on. CINCO ESTRELLA settled off the early pace, raced in the four path through the turn then finished with good energy to be closing in late. SEAPOPS settled back while off the inside, bid from the five path into the lane and finished willingly. BLUE RYDER RED was unhurried early while in the three path, remained well back into the lane then was quickly gaining momentum when running up on rivals, checking and losing momentum. ARROSON chased the pace from the two path into the lane, was inching up on the winner when struck by the whip of the runner-up, ducked in and lost chance. BOOT SCOOTIN BABY chased the pace from along the inside into the lane, had an open rail then hung late. WIND RIDER chased the pace from the two or three path into the lane, remained in contention inside the eighth pole then weakened. OAK RICH was never a threat while in the six path into the lane. STEEL RED never menaced while in the three or four path. CRAFTY SCOUT was finished after a half along the inside. MOROX was outrun along the inside.
