HAWK ON THE HUNT set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn then remained clear in the stretch while drifting in and out and held in the final stages. GLOSS stalked the pace early, angled into the five path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. TANGO UNO (BRZ) chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch run. KING SNAKE lunged at the start and hit the gate, pressed the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and weakened late in the stretch. BLACK DIAMOND BAY was done early. SUPERLAGRA was never a threat. MR. RICO showed little. WILD ALEX was restrained early, angled off the rail into the far turn and was empty in the stretch.
