SPIRITUAL ORDER settled off the pace while in the three path, fanned into the five path in the lane, caught the pacesetters outside the eighth pole and drove past. RAHY NIJMIS chased the pace from the two or three path and moved up while not a threat to the winner. CRAFTY SCOUT chased the pace from the two or three path into the lane, was well placed with an eighth to go then weakened. SLIVER was in the four or five path into the lane and moved up. R. P. INDY was in the three or four path into the lane and never factored. INTRUDER vied for the lead while two wide then faded through the lane. EZEL was outrun from the three or four path. INDIANA GOLD was through early while near the inside. GUNNER vied for the lead along the inside into the lane then retreated from the inside. STEEL RED was bumped and shut off at the start and lost his chance.
