Footnotes

FOREVER SURE set the pace under pressure into the far turn, was asked for more and quickly widened through the lane while under a hand drive. MR. WATT stalked the winner three wide into the turn, bid entering the lane, was no match for the winner while clearly second best. BAD BRAD was unhurried early while near the inside, moved up through the turn from the two path and passed rivals to just get up for third. SUBTROPICAL chased the three horse pace into the turn then lacked a closing bid. RON STOPPABLE was in the three or four path through the turn and was empty in the lane. CUT MAN pressed the winner two wide through the turn then was finished at the quarter pole. SIOSTRA MAN was in tight at the start, was close into the backstretch then steadily lost ground. GO FOR FOUR BUDDY raced in the three or four path into the backstretch, was losing ground readily entering the far turn and was eased to the wire.
