Footnotes

GRANNYS GREEN EYES was unhurried early while near the inside, bid in late turn, split rivals three wide into the lane, caught the leader inside the eighth pole and inched to the front. CHARMING SHE IS was unhurried while off the rail, moved five wide through the turn and into the lane, gained a clear lead with an eighth to go then could not hold off the winner while second best. MAD MAGIC was bumped at the start, raced close up and near the rail into the lane, was blocked inside the eighth pole then finished with good energy to be best of the rest. BANDI'S GAL was in the three path through the turn, fanned into the seven path for the drive and moved up while not a serious threat. REPEAT was along the inside into the lane, had an open rail in the lane then hung in the critical stages. MOTHER WARRIOR chased the pace form the three or four path through the turn and weakened in the drive. START STREET was in the seven path into the lane and never factored. CASTLE PRINCESS stalked the pace two wide into the lane and faded. TAVERNIER BLUE was done after entering the far turn from the three or four path. JUSTICE SCORES was steadiated at the start when inside rival came out, hustled to the lead, remained on the front end into the lane then suddenly gave way. OUT OF MY MIND trailed throughout while off the inside.
