## Footnotes

STARSHIP SUPREME set the pace along the inside while under pressure, shook off challenger into the turn, opened a clear advantage into the lane and held while under intermittent pressure. QSAR (GER) chased the winner from the rail into the lane, moved closest to that one with a furlong to go then could only offer a mild gain while second best. RAILROAD chased the winner from the two path into the turn then lacked the needed response. SIX PACK ABS was unhurried while in the three path through the turn and launched a bid into the lane and gained mildly. WAR SKY stalked the winner into the lane and weakened in the drive. HARLAN RUSH was in the two or three path into the lane and moved up while never a threat. SAHMMY DAVIS JR was unhurried from off the inside, bid four wide near the quarter pole, appeared a menacing presence entering the lane and flattened out. HE'S DANGEROUS was in contention through the turn, came four wide in the lane and tired. ROYALE ducked in at the start, raced along the rail and never menaced. PLEASE INCLUDE ME was outrun from off the rail.
