**Footnotes**

RED LIGHT RUNNER was away alertly to gain the lead from the outset, remained on an open advantage through the turn then quickly widened after straightening in the lane and was kept to the task to the end. KISSIN STAR trailed for half while off the inside, swung widest into the lane and moved up for the place spot while never a threat. LITTLE TANTRUM was in the three path through the turn and held third while never a factor. DREAMING OF TAYLOR was along the inside throughout and never factored. PLEASUREVILLE MISS chased the winner from the three path through the turn and was empty in the lane. GENEVIEVE LADY was in the three path through the turn and tired.
