Footnotes

RAPID WARRIOR set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then drew off in the stretch while being ridden out to the wire. DAMION E. T. was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. NORTHERN REVEAL lost irons early in the backstretch, angled into the three path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. HUNTINGTON'S BEST was bumped at the start then chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. STORMIN' BUFFALO was bumped at the start and well placed early, angled into the three path in the turn with no rally in the stretch. DRAKE'S DANCER tracked pace early from the inside, steadied in the turn and was empty in the stretch. FLYLIKABIRD was through after a half. COMING ON hopped at the start and was done early.
