SPIFFY NIFFY was bothered early after leaving the gate then stalked the early pace, floated by the leader through the turn and drew off late in the stretch under a steady drive. CHAMPAGNE CLOWIE broke slowly from the gate, fanned into the seven path in the turn then rallied in the stretch and was up for place in the final stages. JUSTALOVESONG was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch and weakened late in the drive. FORBIDDEN ANGEL was bothered early, angled into the three path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. STEP CHILD angled into the four path in the turn and improved position. MABEE MONK was on the inside into the turn and was empty late in the stretch drive. MABEE A ROSE came in early along the backstretch. WALLSTREET SPIDER was through after a half. THE SCOOPS ON RUTH was bothered early. BETTINONAPAIRADICE had early speed then folded up. TERESA'S ROSE had brief speed then retreated. SUZIE'S GIFT was done early.
