BADGER BO trailed the field early, angled into the three path in the far turn then circled the field and rallied in the stretch then edged past the leader late. ROYALE WITH SPEED stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then led in the stretch and was caught late. A ROGUE SNUCK IN dueled early, angled into the three path in the far turn and faltered late in the stretch run. MOONSHINE STILL chased the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the far turn and weakened late. GREGORY'S TRICK was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the far turn with no late bid. RADAR MAN was well placed early, angled off the rail into the far turn while no threat. RYAN'S THUNDER had early speed then retreated.
