**Footnotes**

MERCEDES CLASS was void of early speed while off the inside, bid through the three path on the far turn, caught the leader inside the eighth pole and quickly drove past. BULBEN ALIBI was in mid-pack down the backstretch, bid quickly through the far turn to gain a clear lead into the lane then had no answer for the winner while clearly second best. TALK IT OUT was unhurried early while off the rail, bid through the three or four path into the lane and moved up. COMMANDER JOHN vied for the lead along the inside then gave way entering the lane. RIDE IN THE PARK bid through the three or four path into the lane and never factored. KARMA DISTRACTION chased the pace from the three path then tired. KAKHAO was in the two or three path into the lane and passed tired ones. WINCHESTER SLEW was in the three or four path into the lane and tired. DRAKE MANOR was through early from off the rail. FLORIDA BLACK TIE vied for the lead two wide into the turn then retreated. DR. SIDNEY was outrun along the inside. VETERAN'S DAY was wide through the first turn and pulled up and was vanned off.
