Footnotes

OUR BLUSHING ROSE was under pressure early while in the two path, shook rivals into the turn to gain a clear advantage then widened through the lane while kept to the task. CELEBRATE NOW was along the inside through the turn when never far back, bid leaving the turn to get nearest the winner then was no match for that one while clearly second best. KEY TO LUCK was near the rail and appeared to gain best stride late to be best of the rest. NO SILVER LINING was in the two path through the turn and never threatened. MAZIES BLING chased the pace from the two path through the turn and was empty in the lane. ARROGANTLY SHABBY was never a factor while saving ground. QUIET POLA chased the winner from the three path into the lane and faded. SAQQARAH raced along the rail into the turn, bore out through mid-turn and was no longer a contender. JAMMER'S JEWEL broke in the air and lost all chance then trailed.
