FORTY FAR NINER was unhurried early while in the four or five path, bid into the lane while six wide, then made the lead with an eighth to go then slowly inched away. CLASSICAL RHYTHM raced in the three path through the turn, came four wide into the lane then could not stay with the winner in the final eighth. SKIP AWAY HENRY raced in the three or four path into the lane then drifted in while gaining momentum. LEFT SEAT LOUIE raced inside into the turn, was steadied entering the far turn then moved up through the lane while not a threat. SIX GEMS chased the pace from off the rail then lacked a bid in the lane. IDON'TNOWHY raced along the inside into the lane then moved up. BELLE OF ORES vided for the lead three wide through the turn then tired. GIT N GO was never a factor while in the three or four path. NEW YORK SOLUTION saved ground throughout to no avail. JUSTLITEONEUP vied for the lead from between rivals into the lane then retreated. JULIE'S M AND N was hustled early to vie for the early lead then was empty for the drive. SYDOR dropped back entering the turn and was outrun.
