FRAN'SINDYPROSPECT stumbled and shut off at the start, angled five wide into the far turn and moved up. HONKY TONK GOLD raced up close early, angled four wide into the far turn and faded late. CHIPS A BOY chased the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn while no threat late. UNBRIDLED DISTRESS stumbled at the start then was rushed up to set the early pace and eventually gave way. PROUD BID was through after a half. KALVIN WITH A K had brief speed then stopped.
